OBJETIVOS

The course content remains functional and focused entirely on improving learner's independence in al areas, especialy in real-life situations such as travel and eating out, asking for and fo lowing directions, health etc. In this course the learner will start to notice an increased confidence when faced with basic functions and will be able to read an English or American newspaper with little difficulty. As with the other levels on the course, there is frequent pronunciation practice and the learner has exposure to long and short sounds, correct regular past tense endings, minimal pairs, elision as well as general vocabulary and sentence level practice. The use of a variety of exercises encompasses different learner styles as well as guaranteeing thorough coverage of the topics covered. All role-plays offer free practice with the topics covered - giving learners the opportunity to participate in spontaneous speaking activities, replicating realistic exchanges.

CONTENIDOS

Unit 1:

Aims: Learn and acquire structures and vocabulary through interactive exercises such as word/sentence-picture association, listening comprehension with short dialogues, and vocabulary practice.

- Activities: Listening and choosing the best option, repeat and choose the sound, gap fills, synonym selection, real-life dubbing.

- Focus: Technology and computing.
- Activities: Vocabulary in context and extended practice.

Practice: Talking about future plans and using comparatives.

Unit 2:

Aims: Acquire topic-specific vocabulary and structures through interactive tasks.

Vocabulary Focus: Weddings and honeymoon trips.

- Vocabulary: Common expressions, adjectives.
- Activities: Vocabulary click, sentence completion, listening and matching.

- Review Grammar: Comparisons, future forms, travel/money exchange.
- Vocabulary: Weddings, common expressions, adjectives.
- Activities: Listening comprehension, pronunciation, multiple choice, film dubbing.

• Skills: Active reading, inference, matching definitions, true/false.
