OBJETIVOS

The course content remains functional and focused entirely on improving learner independence in all areas, motivating the learner to become conversant on subjects such as the news, politics, ecology, education and employment. In terms of grammatical structures there will be continued revision and extension of the structures in all tenses. Productive and receptive skills are stretched with more phrasal verbs, idiomatic expressions, the differences between British and American vocabulary, expressing hopes and desires, asking indirect questions and making deductions about the past. As with the other levels on the course, there is frequent pronunciation practice and the learner has exposure to long and short sounds, correct regular past tense endings, vowel sounds, elision, homophones as well as general vocabulary and sentence level practice. The use of a variety of exercises encompasses different learner styles as well as guaranteeing thorough coverage of the topics covered. The course is comprised of a series of interactive exercises such as word-picture association, listening comprehension with realistic dialogues and student-led listening practice with the vocabulary items. AI role-plays offer free practice with the topics covered - giving learners the opportunity to participate in spontaneous speaking activities, replicating realistic exchanges.

CONTENIDOS

Unit 1

That Name Rings a Bell

Objectives: Learn and internalize vocabulary and structures related to the topic through interactive exercises like image association, short listening dialogues, and self-paced vocabulary listening practice.

Vocabulary: leaflet, to set up, crafts, fair, ambitious, spotlight, alternative medicine, environment, and habitat.

I Find It Fascinating

Objectives: Learn and practice grammar, more structures and vocabulary through interactive exercises.

Structures and functions: reported speech, indirect questions, expressing agreement and disagreement using "so do I", "neither do I", "I agree", "I disagree", as well as relative pronouns and clauses.

Vocabulary: useful phrases such as "in my opinion", "the general public", "it rings a bell", "I can't take it seriously", and "craft fair", plus environmental terms.

Activities: listening gap fills, multiple choice, repetition practice, sentence completion, writing.

Objectives: Review and consolidate grammar, structures, and vocabulary.

Structures and functions: expressing agreement/disagreement, indirect questions, defining and non-defining relative clauses.

Vocabulary: environment-related.

Activities: silent letter pronunciation, choosing the correct word, listening gap fills, error correction, dubbing real dialogues, synonym identification.

Biotechnology - Reading

Skills: Reading for comprehension with questions on biotechnology.

Activities: multiple choice, true/false, sentence-section matching.

Skills developed: listening analysis, segmentation, memory, processing speed.

Cloud Seeding - Dictation

Objectives: Improve listening, spelling, punctuation, vocabulary, syntax, grammar, and proofreading.

Text dictation by paragraph with repeatable audio.

Role-play: I Was Wondering...

Interview with a football player practicing indirect questions.

Structures and functions: past deduction using "must have", "could have", "might have", 3rd conditional, "ought to have", "should(n't) have", expressing regret, "I wish"/"If only" + past, connectors: although, however, nevertheless, due to.

Vocabulary: expressions like "on the whole", "point of view", "out of work", "you never know", "you won't get away with it", news categories: politics, economy, ecology, weather, sport, crime.

Activities: dialogue continuation, gap fills, word definition match, true/false listening, picture-based sentence formation.

I Wish

Objectives: Consolidate grammatical structures.

Activities: homophones, correct tense gap fill, news type matching, dictation, dubbing.

Role-play: Advice

Giving advice on a friend's problem.
