OBJETIVOS

This course for pre-intermediate learners presents vital aspects of the English language, with content at the B1.2 level of the CEFR. By covering the essential grammar and vocabulary needed to talk about the future, make suggestions, express duration and talk about the cinema, the course gives learners the necessary tools to start using the language straight away. Learners also see how to use relative pronouns, use the gerund for a range of purposes and discuss rules and obligations. Learners participate in role-play and conversation activities which encourage them to use the language spontaneously and meaningfully. The writing and speaking assignments that follow offer the chance to use the language in a range of situations. The student needs to follow the instructions to create short written and spoken texts which allow them to reuse the new language independently.

CONTENIDOS

Unit 1

Role-play: It's someone who... quiz - Contestant

In this lesson the student will participate in a role-play to practise using relative pronouns.

Conversation class: Have you met anyone new recently?

This conversation class provides practice at distinguishing between verbs that are often confused.

Students answer the teacher's questions and use the target language.

Speaking assignment: A person I admire

In this lesson learners record a short audio talking about someone they admire (a family member, a friend, or a famous person).

Writing assignment: Similar words

This short writing assignment tests the learner's ability to distinguish between commonly confused words.

Unit 2

Role-play: Plans

In this lesson the student will participate in a role-play to practise talking about future plans and arrangements.

Conversation class: Looking to the future

This conversation class provides practice using a range of future tenses.

Students talk with the teacher and answer questions using the appropriate future tenses for different situations.

Speaking assignment: Predictions

In this lesson learners submit a short audio recording talking about their predictions for the future.

Writing assignment: Houses in the future

In this lesson learners write a short paragraph describing what houses will be like in the future.

Unit 3

Role-play: Catching up with a friend

In this lesson the student will participate in a role-play to practise talking about a recent past experience.

Conversation class: What happened?

This conversation class provides practice talking about past experiences.

Students talk with the teacher and share some personal anecdotes.

Speaking assignment: Life experiences

In this lesson learners record a short audio talking about some important experiences in their life.

Writing assignment: Unexpected

In this lesson learners write a paragraph about a time when they had an emergency while travelling.

Unit 4

Role-play: What shall we eat?

This role-play provides practice at reaching an agreement, making suggestions as well as talking about food.

Conversation class: Kitchen stories

In this conversation class the learner will talk about some of their best and worst moments regarding food and cooking.

Speaking assignment: Planning a Dinner Party

In this lesson learners record an audio about how they are planning a dinner party for their friends.

Writing assignment: Cooking Advice

In this lesson learners write a message to a friend explaining a recipe.

Unit 5

Role-play: Helping tourists

This role-play encourages the learner to talk about duration and answer questions about tourist attractions.

Conversation class: How long does it take?

In this lesson the student will participate in a conversation class to practise talking about duration.

Speaking assignment: It takes about 10 minutes

This task encourages the learner to talk about the duration of their journeys to different places.

Writing assignment: A travel blog post

In this lesson learners write a blog post about a place they have visited or would like to visit.

Unit 6

Role-play: Escape room rules

This role-play encourages the learner to talk about rules and prohibition in the context of an escape room.

Conversation class: Rules and obligations

In this lesson the student will participate in a conversation class to practise using must and mustn't to talk about rules and obligations.

Speaking assignment: Advice to a Tourist

In this lesson students record a short audio giving advice to a tourist who is visiting their country for the first time.

Writing assignment: Pet Care Rules

In this lesson learners write a text message to a friend about the rules to take care of their pet.

Unit 7

Role-play: Retirement plans

This lesson encourages the learner to use the -ing form of verbs to talk about abilities and skills.

Conversation class: Are you good at singing?

This conversation class provides practice discussing skills and abilities.

Students talk with the teacher about the images they see, commenting on what they can see and their own abilities.

Speaking assignment: How Things Work

In this lesson learners record a short audio explaining how an object works.

Writing assignment: My favourite pastime

In this lesson learners write about their favourite pastime.

Unit 8

Role-play: Cinema

This lesson provides the learner with practice at dealing with questions and giving information in the context of the cinema.

Conversation class: Do you like action films?

This conversation class provides practice talking about films and the cinema.

Students talk with the teacher about the images they see, discussing preferences and observations.

Speaking assignment: The Future of Cinema

In this lesson learners record a short audio talking about how films and cinema are changing.

Writing assignment: A Movie Review

In this lesson learners write a review of a film they have recently watched.
