OBJETIVOS

This course for intermediate learners presents vital aspects of the English language, with content at the B2.1 level of the CEFR. By covering the essential grammar and vocabulary needed to talk about past habits and states, form questions and refer to finished or continuing actions in the future, the course gives learners the necessary tools to start using the language straight away. Learners also see how to give effective instructions, express opinions and talk about parts of a car. Learners participate in role-play and conversation activities which encourage them to use the language spontaneously and meaningfully. The writing and speaking assignments that follow offer the chance to use the language in a range of situations. The student needs to follow the instructions to create short written and spoken texts which allow them to reuse the new language independently

CONTENIDOS

Unit 1

Lesson: Role-play – Survey

Practise using question forms and talking about hobbies and free time activities.

Lesson: Conversation class - Hobbies

Opportunity to talk about hobbies and free time activities.

Speaking assignment: How people spend their free time

Learners think about different ways people spend free time and record their ideas.

Writing assignment: The benefits of hobbies

Write a formal letter to a magazine explaining why hobbies are important for mental and physical health.

Unit 2

Lesson: Role-play – Local history

Practise talking about the past and using correct pronunciation of regular verbs in the past simple.

Lesson: Conversation class – I used to play tennis

Practice with be/get used to.

Discussion on becoming accustomed to new things and adjusting habits or routines.

Speaking assignment: How my town has changed

Learners talk about how their town or neighbourhood has changed over the years.

Writing assignment: Life before technology

Write an article for a language school magazine about how life was different before modern technology.

Unit 3

Lesson: Role-play – Spa break (1)

Practise asking for specific information.

Lesson: Conversation class – At the airport

Discussion about experiences at airports and travelling.

Speaking assignment: A trip I nearly missed

Tell a personal anecdote about a trip nearly missed due to unexpected problems.

Writing assignment: A travel mishap

Write a short story about an unexpected event while travelling.

Unit 4

Lesson: Role-play – The Next Era of Travel

Discuss what travel will look like in the future.

Lesson: Conversation class – Travelling

Discuss the topic of travel and holidays in general.

Speaking assignment: How will we travel in the future?

Make predictions about how travel and transport will change.

Writing assignment: The future of travel

Write an article about how travel and transport will change in the future.

Unit 5

Lesson: Role-play – Renting a car (customer)

Practise renting a car as a customer, answering questions and stating preferences.

Lesson: Conversation class – It's a pleasure

Discussion on being polite when travelling and socialising (manners and etiquette).

Speaking assignment: Hanging out with friends

Talk about socialising with friends using common expressions and phrasal verbs.

Writing assignment: Renting a car

Write an email to book a hire car for a holiday.

Unit 6

Lesson: Role-play – Room attendant duties

Use vocabulary related to household chores and give simple instructions.

Lesson: Conversation class - Housework

Practice discussing household chores, likes and dislikes.

Speaking assignment: Housework responsibilities

Describe a typical day and household responsibilities.

Writing assignment: My least favourite chore

Write about a least favourite household chore.

Unit 7

Lesson: Role-play – Have you ever forgotten your lines?

Ask questions using the present perfect and past simple about a famous actor's life.

Lesson: Conversation class - Bucket list

Practise using the present perfect (life experiences) and past simple (detailed replies).

Speaking assignment: Achievements and experiences

Discuss life achievements and experiences.

Writing assignment: The unexpected change in plans

Write a short story about a time when plans unexpectedly changed.

Unit 8

Lesson: Role-play - In a Café

Talk about preferences and ask for suggestions based on requests.

Lesson: Conversation class – I love walking in the rain

Practise expressing preferences in different ways.

Answer questions and share feelings about different topics.

Speaking assignment: Things I love and hate

Talk about things loved and disliked by answering questions.

Writing assignment: My ideal weekend

Write about an ideal weekend, describing enjoyable and disliked activities.
